To the Embassy of Cameroon in Japan

I the undersigned, have jointed following required documents (ticked checkboxes):

- A Form for Birth Certificate Application** to be filled and signed;
- Medical birth certificate of the child:**
 - For a child born in Japan:**
 - Legalized copy of the "Birth Notification & Birth Certificate" form ("shusseitodoke-no kisaijiko") with city officers' seals issued at the municipality or the local Legal Affairs Bureau;
 - Its translation in English or in French by a company recommended by the Embassy;
 - For a child born abroad:**
 - Medical Birth Certificate issued at the hospital and/or Birth Certificate issued at the Civil Registry (Civil Registration Centre) ;
 - its translation in English or French by an approved translation company;
- Parents' documents:**
 - Original of Cameroonian Marriage Certificate of the parents;
 - Original of Passports of the parents: Father's Mother's ;
 - Original of Cameroon National Identity Card if possible (if available, even expired),
 - Both sides colour copy on one page of Residence Card of parents;
 - Original of Birth Certificate:
 - Cameroonian parent(s):
 - the original;
 - a Duplicata;
 - a Certificate of Existence of Strain;
 - a Certified True Copy.
 - Non Cameroonian parent:
 - the original
 - a Copy of an Extract of Birth
 - its translation by an approved translation company (if in foreign language);
- A prepaid envelope Letter Pack (blue or red) of the Post Office, with my address already filled.
- Returning fees for residents abroad:*
 - I have transfered EMS fees for the amount of JPY.
 - I have a DHL account for payment on delivery.
 - I will call the local DHL for pick up to DHL JAPAN.
